

c. How to Apply

- ① Choose one of the two (2) designated Korean universities according to your region and major. You can choose only one of the two universities for your application. You are not allowed to apply to more than one university. Multiple applications will be excluded during the final selection process.
- ② Submit required documents to the chosen application office.
- ③ If you pass the document screening, you will be invited for an interview from your application office. Interviews will be conducted by either Skype or phone.
- d. Application Deadline : May 2nd
- * Applications will be processed on the first come first serve basis.

e. Required Documents

- ① Completed Application Form
- ② A Copy of the Passport Information Page
- 3 Proof of Enrollment from Currently Enrolled University
- 4 Original Sealed Transcript from Currently Enrolled University
- (5) Self Introduction and Research Plan
- ⑥ A Letter of Recommendation from an Academic Source
- * Note: Additional documents may be required from the university you apply to.

For documents ①, ⑤ and ⑥, you should use the provided template.



Benefits

- a. NIIED and/or the training institutions will be responsible for round trip air ticket, room and board during the duration of the program, and traveler's insurance.
- b. Participants will be responsible for transportation fare in his/her country, visa fee, etc.

Activities	Contents
Orientation	Introduction to the overall program
Lectures	Specific field of study Korean language, history and culture
Research Project, Lab Activities, Seminars etc.	Conduct specific research projects along with mentoring from Korean graduate students
Field Trip	Related laboratories, research institutes and/or industrial sites, Cultural or historical sites
Closing	Presentation of research results, Awards to the outstanding performances, Formation of Alumni network
